

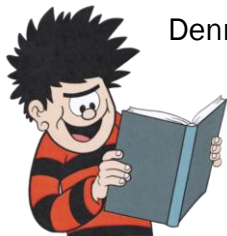

This year Mischief Makers Summer Reading Challenge takes us all to Beanotown, where rumour has it there's a treasure chest full of epic pranks waiting to be discovered. Mischief Makers is inspired by the much-loved Beano, which celebrates its 80th anniversary.

For children aged 4 to 11, taking part in the Challenge is simple – sign up for free at your local library, read any six library books of your choice including eBooks and collect stickers to add to your very own map of Beanotown. Dennis, Gnasher and friends will help you solve clues having lots of fun and adventures along the way to discover where the treasure is hiding!

The challenge starts in Burton Bradstock Community Library on Saturday 7th July.



Dennis and the Beano are all about “Maximum Fun” so this year the children are invited to bring in their favourite jokes to create a Bumper Fun Joke Book for Burton Bradstock Community Library. The jokes should be no more than A4, preferably just a few lines. We will reserve the right to reject any jokes with inappropriate content.

If you complete the challenge at Burton Bradstock and show us on the map where the treasure is buried, bring in a joke or answer one of the questions displayed in the Library, you will be able to have a lucky dip no more than one per child (*while stocks last*).
