About the Trust

Formed in 2005, The Trust took over the administration and maintenance of the Village Hall from the WI who had it built in the 1930's.

The objective of the Trust is to run and maintain the Hall for the benefit of the Village and those who live in it.

The Committee is made up of a mixture of members elected via the AGM and representatives of the main activity groups in the Village.

About the Hall

Built in 1931, the Hall is the mainstay of most Village activities that require space or fundraising activities to operate. The Hall can accommodate up to 120 people in a range of formats and is regularly used for activities such as presentations, charity lunches and dinners, amateur dramatics, film nights, bridge, art classes, yoga, brownies, badminton, pilates, quizzes and coffee mornings.

It is well equipped with all the tables, chairs, kitchen equipment and audio systems to accommodate virtually any need.
