#### **NOTES**

#### 1 Reserves Policy.

Our general reserves equate approximately to 6 month's expenditure.

Our situation as a Charity impels us to be prudent with our reserves but not to carry more than we need in our general reserve account. The PCC has decided to keep General Reserves near 6 months expenditure and are using Restricted Administration Funds to pay part of our Parish Share. Since the Administration Fund will be exhausted in 2014 the PCC will be encouraging increased giving to the General Fund.

- 2 The financial statements of the PCC have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 using the Receipts and Payments Basis.

- The expenses paid to clergy and others may include a small immaterial proportion, which relates to their function as PCC members. No other payments were made to PCC members.
