#### OLD TESTAMENT READINGS Isaiah 54:5-14

5 - Your Maker is your husband, The LORD of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth.

6 - For the LORD has called you like a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, like a youthful wife when you were refused," says your God.

7 - "For a mere moment I have forsaken you, but with great mercies I will gather you.

8 - With a little wrath I hid My face from you for a moment; but with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you," says the LORD, your Redeemer.

9 - "For this is like the waters of Noah to Me; For as I have sworn that the waters of Noah would no longer cover the earth, so have I sworn That I would not be angry with you, nor rebuke you.10 - For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but My kindness shall not depart

from you, Nor shall My covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has mercy on you. 11 - "O you afflicted one, tossed with tempest, and not comforted, behold, I will lay your stones with colourful gems, and lay your foundations with sapphires.

# NEW TESTAMENT READING Luke 10: 1-9

1 - After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.

2 - Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into His harvest.

3 - "Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves.

4 - "Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road.

5 - "But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.'

6 - "And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you.

7 - "And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the labourer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house.

8 - "Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you.

9 - "And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'

# REFLECTION

When was the last time you went to the Doctor to talk about a problem? Was it helpful? Those of us who have lived & worked abroad often say "We are so blessed in the UK with our NHS. Thank God for our Drs, nurses, dentists."

I guess we are especially grateful after a medical examination or tests to hear those three words 'It's Good news'

Today we celebrate the feast of Luke the Evangelist. Luke was a multi-tasker

1<sup>st</sup> he was a Doctor (Paul in Colossians 4:14 calls *Luke the beloved physician*) hence his interest in peoples' medical conditions

2<sup>nd</sup> he was a Writer. Having *researched the facts* (as Luke says in his introduction to our 3<sup>rd</sup> Gospel) I write to you, Theophilus, giving you an orderly account ... so that you can know the truth and 3<sup>rd</sup> he was a missionary - who supported St Paul in the proclamation of the good news about Jesus.

It is interesting that in his record of Jesus' ministry he is the only writer who gives an account in Luke 10 of the sending out of the 70 *After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also to go where he would go.* 

Because Luke was a non-Jew he had a special interest in the non-Jewish world. That is why he dedicated his book to Theophilus - the Greek

Luke in ch 24:47 also recalls Christ's last command that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to ALL nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

So after giving us the account of the commissioning of the 12 apostles to the Jews Luke tells us about 70 others sent to every city Jesus would go - (like Tyre & Sidon), so prefiguring the whole church (Jew & non-Jew) hearing and taking the message of Jesus to every nation and people. This he describes as a great Harvest.

Back in ch 10:2 Luke zooms in on Christ's words *The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into His harvest.* 

-This harvest involves prayer and people going *therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers.* 

-Then Jesus warns them that this harvest would be risky I send you out as lambs among wolves. -it would be financially challenging Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and eat what you are given.

-it would be life changing whatever house you enter first say, 'Peace to this house. and if the Son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it. If not, it will return to you', adding heal the sick there, saying to them, 'God's kingdom of has come near to you.'

The Prince of Peace calls **us** above all to share his peace - his peace that heals hearts, minds and bodies.

Earlier in Matthew 5 Jesus advocated the blessing of peace - *Blessed are the peacemakers* How lovely to be able to receive and give the gift peace.

This is the good news all people need to hear and have and hand on (not just in church when we say The Peace, but wherever we go) It's a bit like the greeting visitors hear echoing throughout Israel - 'Shalom'

Peacemakers have, and hold out for all, 'Peace'. This peace is peace with God and peace with people. It is Peace of mind, peace of heart, peace of body. It is a Peace that the world cannot understand, it's a peace that comes in the person and name of Jesus. Amen

Thank you Father for our neighbours, friends and families. May your shalom peace be in their hearts and homes, and in ours. And always give us gratitude for all your blessings, most especially for Jesus Christ our Lord without whom life would be meaningless
