### Readings Old Testament Isaiah 55: 1 - 11

1 "Ho! Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

2 Why do you spend money for what is not bread. And your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me. and eat what is good, and let your soul delight itself in abundance.

3 Incline your ear, and come to Me. Hear, and your soul shall live; And I will make an everlasting covenant with you - the sure mercies of David.

6 Seek the LORD while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near.

7 Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the LORD, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.

8 "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways," says the LORD.

9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.

10 "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower and bread to the eater,

11 So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

#### The epistle comes from 2 Timothy 3.14 -4-5

14 But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them.

15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

16 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His 1 appearing and His kingdom:

2 Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.

3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;

4 and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.

5 But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry The Gospel comes from John 5: 36b -end

36 But I have a greater witness than John's; for the works which the Father has given Me to finish - the very works that I do - bear witness of Me, that the Father has sent Me.

37 "And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

38 "But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, Him you do not believe.

39 "You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

- 40 "But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.
- 46 "If you believed Moses, you would believe Me; for he wrote about Me.

47 "But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe My words?"

Reflection

What's you favourite food? We all enjoy eating, but, is what we eat 'good' food or 'junk food'? But what is good food? Just look on the internet Isaiah says: Eat what is good.

## - NHS has a site called Eat Well ... Live well

Eating a healthy, balanced diet is an important part of maintaining good health, and can help you feel your best - Medicalnewstoday.com says: The top fifteen healthful foods; are. Nuts. pulses, and grains, fruits, vegetables, and berries, fish, meat, and eggs eaten in balance and moderation.

However when Isaiah says Eat what is good he isn't just talking about food for our bodies, but food, nourishment, for our soul

What gives us life and health .... and develops us spiritually? God says through Isaiah 55:11 it's My word ... that goes forth from My mouth

and Paul agrees with that

When writing to young Timothy he said in 2Tim3:15 from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. Tim's Mum and Gran had an 'Open the Book' project (like us in school)

We Open God's Book because the Bible says: ALL Scripture is given by inspiration of God (it is "God breathed") It is profitable for doctrine, for reproof for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete (fit/strong) thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Paul in his first letter to Timothy wrote: What holds you and the Church of God up is THE pillar - the pillar of Truth Truth is not a nebulous, situational, variable thing but a clear black & white, 'hard copy' thing.... it's the Word of God, the eternal, unchanging 'truth' infused by the Spirit and enlivened by prayer

Paul (whilst encouraging Timothy to personally feed on this good food) warned him about bad food... a time will come when people will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, having itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers who will turn their ears away from the truth .... to fables Reinterpretation very often means removal!

Paul had already warned about this in his first letter .... the Spirit expressly says: in latter times (and that's the time WE live in) that some will depart from the faith (they had it and lost it) How? by giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons (Satan is behind all deception, deviation, & destruction); those 'deceived' deceivers ... speak two faced lies (in hypocrisy) because their own conscience has been seared with a hot iron

Similarly Jesus denounced the religious leaders of his day saying: You do not have God's Word abiding in you. You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; (having a Bible doesn't save) these Scriptures are they which testify of Me; and you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life. How do we know truth from error? Error shows itself

1. when Jesus and his Work is moved from the centre of our faith; and 2. when Jesus and his Word is moved from the centre of the church's teaching.

We need Jesus in our hearts.... and the Bible in our heads

It's not just about having a bible but reading and feeding on it daily like food Eat what is good says Isaiah In these days, more and more, we need God's Word to counteract the deceits and lies of Satan.

Recently I heard a Church Leader say: You can only tell what is a lie ... when you know what is the truth. We will fall for deception every time when we don't know The Truth!! That's why Jesus in John 17 prayed for his followers: Father, keep and sanctify them through The Truth - Your Word is truth

David wrote that in Psalm 119:160 - The entirety of Your word is truth.

Isaiah, hearing from God, wrote: As the rain waters the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, so shall My Word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please It's God's Truth (His Word) that makes for a fruitful, & fulfilling life & stops us from being deceived

In these dark, difficult and deceptive days - how we need the light of the Bible

I heard a black preacher (on emigrating to the UK) say: You Brits are wonderful: you brought us the Gospel and God's Word and now we have come to you to bring you back to it

So many in the UK are confused and ignorant about God's truth. We have our Bibles, but don't know them as we should.

The Bible Society wants to .....

1<sup>st</sup> bring the Bible to ALL Nations - especially where there's such a hunger to know what God says.

It believes what keeps people abroad going in drought, in disasters, disease, division, deprivation and despotism, in poverty as well as in prosperity ..... is God's Word That's why some of us support the Bible a Month project 2<sup>nd</sup> The Bible Society wants to bring people here in the UK back to the Bible through The Bible Course, Open the Book, and Bible in a Year because God's word is like food for life; it's strength and security; it's direction and light. But above all because the Bible centres on Jesus the one and only Saviour
