

PLANS FOR THE CHURCH TO BE NET ZERO BY 2030

The General Synod has endorsed the CofE's plans to achieve 'Net Zero' for church buildings and schools. The Bishop of Norwich says, "This work is central to our story with God and creation; central to our story about God and creation. And I see it as a key part of our obedience to God's call to be stewards of creation. The Routemap has been refined in consultation. It's pragmatic, it's a step-by-step approach. It charts the territory into an unknown landscape, with the best knowledge that we currently have. But no doubt it will need to flex and to adapt as the wider picture changes in the coming years."
