Old Testament Reading Isaiah 2:1-5

- 1 This is what Isaiah son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem:
- 2 In the last days the mountain of the LORD's temple will be established as chief among the mountains; it will be raised above the hills, and all nations will stream to it.
- 3 Many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion, the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
- 4 He will judge between the nations and will settle disputes for many peoples. They will beat their swords into ploughshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war any more.

When Billy Graham 1st came to UK his organisation put on an amazing and fascinating Advertising campaign Suddenly posters appeared all over the place saying: *He is coming*

Then, later, new ones appeared asking: Who is coming?

And after a few more weeks the posters then explained: *Billy Graham is coming* - including the different places and dates of the events when he'd be speaking.

It all created quite a stir Brits weren't used to that sort of advertising

Yet it's nothing new. In fact It's a bit like Advent. What's Advent mean? It's from the Latin and means COMING The Bible, from first to last, promises and proclaims: *He is Coming*

The first book of the Bible, Genesis, begins with the Creation (that God made it), The Fall (how mankind spoilt it) and the 1st Promise that God would rectify the situation

Genesis 3:14,15 tells us how God judged the Serpent (Satan) and in the same breath Promised a Saviour:

And I will put enmity between you (Satan) and the woman (Eve); between your offspring and her offspring (the promised Deliverer) He will crush your head when you will strike his heel

Right at the beginning of everything, God declared: a Seed is coming - He is coming

Later in Genesis God promised Abraham, the 1st Patriarch, "In your seed (in your offspring) all the nations of the earth shall be blessed

Abraham was given great promises, and had great hopes. Look, He's coming.

Later the Patriarch Jacob in Gen 49:10 blessed his 4th son Judah with a promise of the Saviour's coming *The sceptre* shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh (the Peace Giver, the Lion of Judah) comes; and to Him shall the obedience of the people be.

Moses (after the prophetic demonstration at the 1st Passover of God's salvation by the protection of a lamb's blood) told Israel in Deuteronomy 18:15 *He is coming!* "The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear.

The Patriarchs had this promise: He is coming

Next week in Advent 2 we will be looking at the prophets who had the same message: *Christ is coming* Isaiah prophesied in ch 7 *Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel;* The promised Seed was to come as a Baby and is God. Also He would come to be our Saviour

Isaiah 53 says: Immanuel would be despised and rejected, wounded for our transgressions, and bruised for our iniquities

Zechariah said: Behold, your King is coming to you ... riding on a donkey.

The Old Testament said *Rejoice*, the child, born to be Saviour and King, Immanuel, is on the way *He's coming* And Christ CAME, just as God said. Remember: We can rely on God's Word, because God keeps his promises But Advent also says: the promised One is coming *again* in the last day as King and Judge

Let's hear our New Testament Reading from Matthew 24:36-44

- 36 "No-one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.
- 37 As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.
- 38 For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark;
- 39 and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.
- 40 Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left.
- 41 Two women will be grinding with a hand mill; one will be taken and the other left.
- 42 "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come.

- 43 But understand this: If the owner of the house had known at what time of night the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and would not have let his house be broken into.
- 44 So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him.

This the Word of the Lord Thanks be to God

Centuries after the promises of Christ's first coming we hear Jesus say three times in Matthew24 I, the Son of Man, will come again

Did you know that the Bible has more to say about Christ's second coming than his first.

Jude (Jesus' step brother!!) pointed to Enoch (Noah's great grandfather in Genesis) who proclaimed: "In the last days, the Lord is coming with 10,000 angels" Jude14

Zechariah, one of the last Old Testament prophets boosted the promise of Christ's first coming in ch 9 into 'the last days' . In ch14 he says: And in that day ... His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives - which will split in two -

This word was confirmed by the angels at Jesus ascension in Acts1, saying: this same Jesus is coming back here again!

Jesus the Babe, Jesus the man, Jesus the shepherd, Jesus the Lawgiver, Jesus the Saviour, Jesus the Lord, Jesus the Judge, Jesus the King is coming

All the writers of the New Testament have something to say about Christ's return in the last days; Matthew, Mark, Luke, Peter, John, Jude, James and Paul

Heb9:26 says He has appeared once to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself; and to those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time for salvation - for the final deliverance

Advent is, in fact, three dimensional. It says: 1st Christ HAS come. 2nd He WILL come. and 3rd He IS come Yes, He is here, now (in church, in your home, on the telephone). He promises (where people seek Me I will be found; and where 2 or 3 gather together in my name, there am I in the midst)

This is his promise. He promised to come and to save, to strengthen and to succour all who call on him

- The past is covered by his blood
- the present is illuminated by his presence
- & the future is secured by his grace and glory

Finally, I love what John prophesied in 1Jn3:3, Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed (when he returns), we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

Hallelujah. Just as Advent came once in Bethlehem so Advent will come because He is coming again Jesus is Coming; he is coming for his own. God promises this in his Word

As the Bible begins with the promise of his coming, the Bible ends with this promise in Rev 22: "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. : He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus

The whole Bible, from first to last, from Genesis to Revelation, constantly promises He is coming

Advent turns our eyes **backwards** to Christ's first coming as the Babe of Bethlehem.

it turns our eyes forward to his second coming at the end of time as King and Judge.

and it turns our eyes **upward** to Christ's coming to meet us here and now in worship

It's not an empty phrase to say The Lord is here, His Spirt is with us

So, let's open our hearts and voices to welcome him now in order to be ready to meet him then.
