

#### **BENEFICE COUNCIL - THE BVN**

The editor of the BVN attended to report on progress of the new BVN Support Group. Discussions included costs per issue (which John Vercoe had analysed) and how these are funded by advertisers and the donations of those who contribute to the BVN, such as some Parish Councils and community groups as well as donations from individuals. It costs almost **50p per issue** per copy and, to print a page each month, **£147 per year**. It was agreed that the Support Group would lead on the BVN going forward and report back to the Benefice Council with thoughts/proposals about advertising rates, advertising on village websites displaying the BVN, editorial discussions and the aims/objectives of the magazine and measures to ensure at least a balanced budget overall.
