

#### **FETE RESULTS AND THANKS**

The weather impacted on all our Village/Church fetes this year but that didn't generally prevent locals and visitors from having a good time. We thank all those who organised and took part in these important annual events which help to secure funding in support of our communities and our church buildings.

**Puncknowle Fete** raised £3069 for the church, Swyre church and the Village Hall **Litton Cheney Fete** in spite of the high winds on the day, £4900 was raised for the church and the school.

**Shipton Gorge Fete:** despite the very poor weather forecast, a much smaller fete & show was held in the Village hall where approx £120 was raised on the cake stall and a further £250 was donated from sales of refreshments.

**Burton Bradstock Church Fete** after a damp morning which, fortunately, dried out for the afternoon, c£6400 was raised towards on-going improvements to the building.
