

BENEFICE AMALGAMATION

On 19th October 2023 the Church Commissioners confirmed the original decision of 26th July 2023 that 'the benefice of Abbotsbury, Portesham and Langton Herring and the benefice of Bride Valley shall be united to create a new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Bride Valley and Chesil". The scheme took place from 1st November 2023 and Revd Margaret Preuss-Higham and Revd Liz Howlett will be licenced in their roles for the whole of the new benefice. The scheme also documents that the Burton Bradstock rectory shall be the place of the incumbent of the new benefice. In keeping with the new benefice, Source to Sea will carry news from all the churches as we look forward to working together and supporting each other. There are many details to work out as we also go through the process of recruiting a new Rector. Please pray for everyone involved at this time of change.
