

THE DIOCESAN VISION: MAKING JESUS KNOWN 2. WORKING FOR JUSTICE

The passage from Luke which underpins the vision Making Jesus Known puts justice firmly at the heart of the mission of the Church. Following Jesus' call means encountering Christ who transforms our own hearts and minds, and committing to sharing this transformative encounter with all those we meet. It means working for justice across society, listening to and magnifying the voices of people facing poverty and injustice, supporting local action and using our voice to challenge injustice wherever it exists. As it also means speaking out on behalf of those who have little voice, particularly the last, the least and the lost. As Christ followers, we must 'insist on the world becoming the way that God wants it to be' (Jacques Ellul). This priority is a direct response to the Fourth Mark of Mission, which challenges us 'to seek to transform unjust structures of society, to challenge violence of every kind and to pursue peace and reconciliation'. By pledging ourselves to action through **Working for Justice** we will be:

- An effective and valued partner to those taking responsibility to improve the lives and communities in which we serve
- A trusted and respected voice in standing up for those whose voice is often unheard in our communities
- A Christ centred diocese which models its aspiration for justice throughout its many parts and structures, including its leadership bodies
