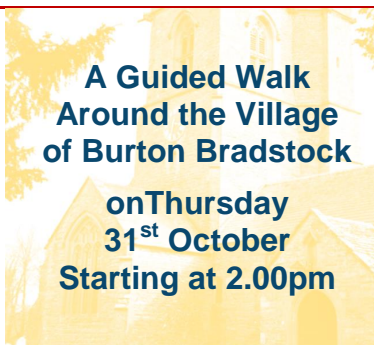


An invitation to all "LEGO Builders" (young and old) to Burton Bradstock Community Library starting at 10.15am.
